Dear Parents/Carers

Year 12 and 13 Visit to University & Apprenticeship Fair at the Emirates Stadium - 1 March 2019

I am writing to inform you that we have secured places for our Year 12 & 13 students to attend the University & Apprenticeship Fair being held at the Emirates Stadium, London on 1 March. We will leave the school by coach at 9.00am and aim to return by 3.00pm traffic allowing.

This informative and inspirational higher education and careers fair is perfect for both Year 12 and 13 students who will either be beginning the process of deciding what pathway they would like to take or finalising their future options to begin this Summer or Autumn. Some of the features of this Fair will be:

- An array of exhibiting universities including the University of Oxford, red brick, Russell Group and modern institutions.
- University seminars will focus on UCAS personal statements, Oxbridge applications and student finance. University seminars are featured within a spacious theatre-style room.
- The Milkround School Leavers Apprenticeship Hall will feature some of the UK's top apprenticeship providers, including Ernst & Young, PwC, Channel 4, IBM, Accenture and Grant Thornton to name but a few.
- Apprenticeship Seminars, including Higher and Degree Apprenticeships.
- Creative, Sport and STEM hubs featuring interactive displays from many of the UK's specialist universities and providers within these fields.
- All students will be provided with a free university/UCAS/apprenticeship application guide brochure, open days and important HE dates wall calendar, pen, and other free promotional student items.

The cost of this trip is **£16.00** per student, which includes transport to and from the venue, parking and insurance. Students should wear smart clothing in accordance with 6th Form uniform expectations, and can bring packed lunch or a small amount of money to purchase lunch and snacks at the venue. Please note that we are now a cashless school and therefore request that, if you would like your son to attend, payments should be made online via the School Gateway. The deadline for payment is **8 February**. When making payment please enter an emergency contact name/number along with any medical conditions in the **comments** box. Please also tick the **consent** box to confirm the following:

I have ensured my son understands that it is important for his safety, and for the safety of the group, that any rules and any instructions given by the staff in charge are obeyed. Should the necessity arise, I agree to the person in charge giving consent on my behalf for an anaesthetic to be administered or for any other urgent medical treatment to be given.
