## Bread Ahead Trip – 22 January 2019



We are delighted to offer a trip to Bread Ahead in Borough Market for Year 10 Food Preparation and Nutrition students. They will take part in the Soda Bread course, and in this 1.5 hour hands-on workshop, students will choose from a selection of ingredients (i.e. cheese and dried fruit) to create a unique soda bread from scratch. They will be guided through the process by an experienced tutor and will learn about raising agents including bicarbonate of soda. We will leave Hayesbrook at 9.00am and walk to Tonbridge train station, and return to Tonbridge Station at approximately 2.30pm. For safety reasons, we will all walk back to the school site and students will be dismissed from there.

### Important information about the visit

Please ensure that pupils wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch. **Students will not be able to stop anywhere to get food.** The Bread Ahead Bakery is only a 5 minute walk from London Bridge train station, but Borough Market is a very busy and lively area of London and students must not wander away from the group.

The cost of this trip is **£23.00** per student to cover activities, travel and insurance. We would like every member of the class to attend if possible. Payment can be made online via the School Gateway. When making payment please enter an emergency contact name/number along with any medical conditions in the **comments** box. Please also tick the **consent** box to confirm the following:
