## The Hayesbrook School Sixth Form Applications

I wanted to write to you with an update regarding Sixth Form applications. As you have made an application to join The Hayesbrook Sixth Form you will be keen to find out how the rest of the application process will work. Now that we have received your application, we are busy writing the timetable and reading over all of the applications. At this stage, like you, we are waiting for the results to be published so that we can make sure that students are able to follow the right courses based on GCSE results.

### GCSE Results

These will be released on Thursday 20 August 2020 and we will write to you before the end of the school year to explain how these can be collected if you are a Hayesbrook student. For external applicants you will be informed by your current school how results will be collected. We will then be available to confirm entry into the Sixth Form with your unconditional offer, at this point it may be appropriate to discuss your selection of courses, using your GCSE grades as a reference point. If this is the case we will discuss this with you on 20 August 2020. We will either plan for face to face or virtual meetings based on the latest government guidance and will share more information with you soon regarding these critical discussions.

### Sixth Form Induction Day

On Wednesday 1 July we will be hosting an 'on demand' induction day for pupils via the school website. From Wednesday morning, students can click on the following link and they will be able to access recorded lessons to gain a further feel for what the subject is like at level 3 and to see and hear the teaching staff.
