Sixth Form Transition Event

I am writing to let you know further information about our Year 11 into Year 12 Sixth Form transition event which will be taking place during the weeks beginning Monday 21 June and Monday 28 June. The aim of this event is to provide your son with an opportunity to experience what life is like in The Hayesbrook School Sixth Form so that when he joins us in September he is ready to start the next stage in his education pathway.

I will be providing further information after the half term break, however, to help you and your son plan his time after he has finished school I would like to let you know that the two weeks will:

- Consist of some shorter days and some days where your son will not need to come into school – this information will be provided nearer the time.
- Enable your son to attend taster lessons in his chosen subjects so that he can experience what his lessons will be like and meet his teachers.
- Take part in team building activities onsite and offsite so that your son can build upon his relationships with his peers.
- Take part in workshops that are being delivered by a variety of external agencies such as Canterbury Christchurch University, Beyond This and ASK Apprenticeships.
- Gain a First Aid Training certificate from Blue Earth Training.

All costs are being covered by the school.

We are delighted that your son has chosen to stay with us to study within our Sixth Form continuing his studies in an environment where he knows staff and students will certainly ease him into his post-16 studies. If your son is still deciding whether to join us please encourage him to attend this event as he is very welcome to come and see what our Sixth Form is about.
