### Changes to the timing of the school day and term dates from September 2021

Further to our letter of 7<sup>th</sup> May, opening a consultation regarding proposed changes to the timings of the school day and term dates for next academic year, we are writing to inform you of the outcome of the consultation.

We have carefully considered all responses from parents, carers, staff and students and we thank all those who took the time to provide feedback, both in support of the changes, and to raise questions or concerns. These comments have been a very important part of our decision making process.

After careful consideration we have taken the decision move forward with the proposed changes for September 2021, and will therefore align our school day and term dates to those of Leigh Academy Trust's (LAT).

The changes in place from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 will be:

1. The school day will end at 2.00pm on Wednesdays. The school day will finish at 2.55pm on all other days.
2. The 2021-22 term dates will change to align to LAT's academy calendar. The updated term dates are now published on the academy website and can be found [here](#).

Thank you for supporting the rationale behind these proposals as part of our work to continue to improve the quality of provision of education for our students.
